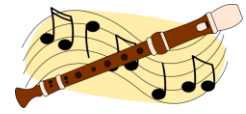




# Welcome to General Music at OPE! 2016-2017 Program Information

## Grading, Standards, & Assessments

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Grading in music at Petersen is based on proficiency toward the National Standards for Music Education. Your child will receive a proficiency grade in singing, playing instruments, and in reading and notating music at least once per year. Students will receive a grade for participation each trimester, which will be separate from the skill grades.

## Recorders

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All OPE students will need access to a soprano recorder for use during the school year. Many of our returning 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will still have their recorders from last year and are welcome to use them again. Families are welcome to select one of three options for acquiring a recorder for their child:

1. Bring a recorder from home
2. Buy a recorder from the school (\$6)
3. Check out a recorder from the school

To make things easier on you, we offer high quality recorders for sale through the school for \$6. These come with a zippered case and will be engraved with your child's name.

Please watch for a supplemental letter home detailing our recorder program and when students will need to begin bringing recorders to class each session. Once we begin work with the recorders, bringing it to class daily will become part of your child's participation grade in music, just as students are responsible for bringing appropriate shoes to PE.
